Something God alone can see.

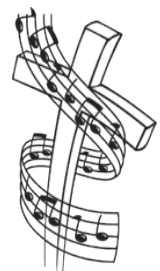

New Office Door Entrance

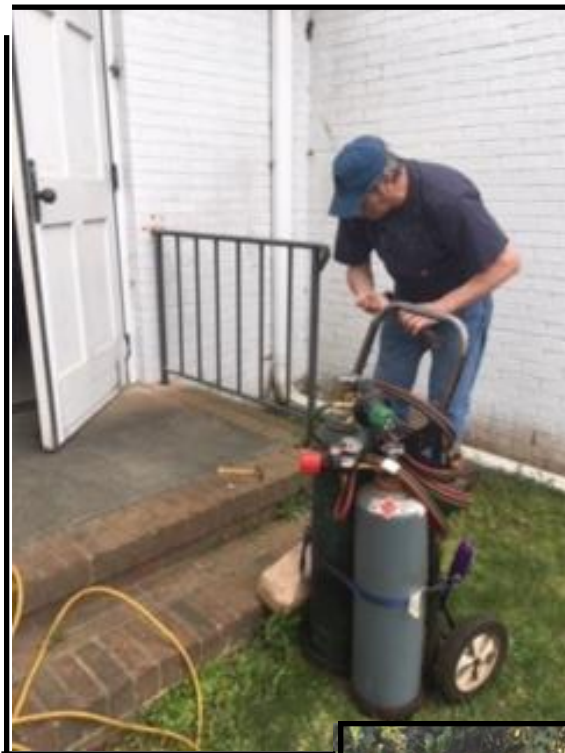
The doorbell that was at the kitchen door has been moved to the doors just outside the nursery.

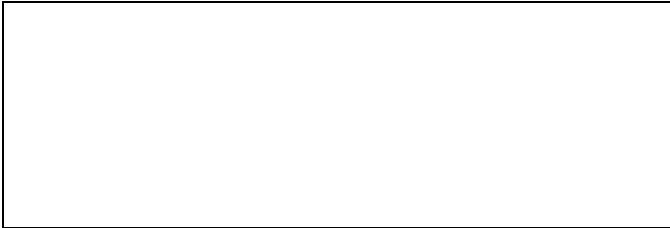
