Beloved,

The Rev. Rick Warren is a controversial figure in some religious circles. He is the Pastor of Saddleback Church (Orange County, CA). Saddleback Church has four campuses, twenty-eight services a week and 83,000 people who worship at those services. Some of you may be familiar with Rev. Warren as the author of <u>The Purpose Driven Life</u>.

He is not always on the same theological wavelength with a lot of UCC pastors, and I beg to differ with him on more than one occasion with respect to his theology. But whether you like him or dislike him, you have to give him credit for his views about the calling of God's church in the world. I can honestly say that I wholeheartedly agree the Rev. Warren's understanding of mission as reaching out, serving the poor and the need for "the rich" to share their blessings.

Through his and his wife's trips to Africa and their commitment to assist AIDS orphans and to battle the AIDS crisis, Rick Warren came to a new understanding of what God was calling him to do. In his own words:

"I felt like the blinders came off. I've got three advanced degrees. I went to two seminaries and a Bible school. How did I miss the 2,000 verses in the Bible where it talks about the poor?"

In spite of our theological differences we can agree that the Bible does indeed talk about the poor and our responsibility to the poor of our world.

We are now in the season of Lent. Part of our UCC Lenten emphasis is to encourage an offering for *One Great Hour of Sharing* (OGHS). This offering will be collected at our worship service on Sunday, March 22nd. It is a part of our *Five for Five* offering, and the one that is supported most strongly within UCC churches. OGHS reaches out to the poor throughout the world through the work of Wider Church Ministries and our ecumenical partners and ecumenical agencies.

In the midst of our uncertain economy and anxiety over the Corona virus we must always remember that we still live in the midst of great riches and good health care when compared with the wider world. I implore you to prayerfully give from your heart this year.






Paul grew up in this church and at the tender age of 10 became a member through confirmation on April 22, 1962.
