Beloved,

Last year during Lent we made the difficult decision to suspend in-person worship until such time as we felt it was safe to gather as one body. Never in my wildest dreams did I think that we would be repeating that sacrifice again this year. We were back together with some of you on Sunday mornings for seven months; however, the pandemic has once again forced a retreat, at least for now. But that is what we do as Christians, we make difficult choices for the sake of others.

During Lent and Holy Week, we remember that God gave the world Jesus, and Jesus gave us his life to show us how to live our own. While many people may think of Lent as a somber time to "give up" things, we might better see it as a time to give our hearts, our

lives, and our gifts in response to God's own gracious generosity in our lives. Despite the pandemic, Lent gives us the opportunity to "reach out," rather than "give up" ... let us mindfully "reach out" to others who feel isolated and fearful during these troubling days. Just a phone call can make all the difference!

While the disciples fell silent on the way to the Cross, others became the 'shouting stones.'. If these were silent, the stones would cry out!" proclaims Jesus to the Pharisees as they demand his disciples cease their "Hosannas!" ~ Luke 19:37-40. These others ... non-disciples ... everyday folk ... are the ones who stand by Jesus in sometimes small but crucial ways and become the shouting stones of Lent.

Our Lenten theme in this sacred season is based on the following words of Teresa of Avila, a Christian Spanish mystic (1515–1582).

> Christ has no body but yours, No hands, no feet on earth but yours, Yours are the eyes with which he looks Compassion on this world, Yours are the feet with which he walks to do good, Yours are the hands, with which he blesses all the world. Yours are the hands, yours are the feet, Yours are the eyes, you are his body. Christ has no body now but yours, No hands, no feet on earth but yours, Yours are the eyes with which he looks compassion on this world. Christ has no body now on earth but yours.

I pray that her words will be a constant reminder to us, not only in Lent, but every day of our lives that we have a role to play in bringing forward God's love, justice and compassion "on earth as it is in heaven."
