Fanny Crosby To God be the Glory, great things he hath done: So loved he the world that he gave us his son, Who yielded his life an atonement for sin, and opened the life gate that all may go in REFRAIN Praise the Lord, praise the Lord, let the earth hear his voice!

Praise the Lord, praise the Lord, let the people rejoice! O come to the Father, through Jesus the Son, And give him the glory, great things he hath done.

Fanny Crosby wrote this hymn in 1870 and its words speak just as true today as they did over 150 years ago. Crosby was a prolific hymn writer in the 1800's with thousands of songs and hymns attributed to her. Her other most well known hymn is, "Blessed Assurance". Crosby understood and shared the words of the Christian faith so eloquently that they have lived on in the hearts and minds of Christians around the world.

"Praise the Lord" for the ministry of Rev. Mary Anne Biggs over the past 3 years. After more than 30 years in music ministry, I can truly say that I will miss Rev.
