Come, ye thankful people, come, raise the song of harvest home; All is safely gathered in, ere the winter storms begin. God our Maker doth provide for our wants to be supplied; Come to God's own temple, come, raise the song of harvest home.

As a child growing up in a New England Congregational church in a farming community, this hymn was sung every year around the time of Thanksgiving. The connection to the seasons and the harvest was very strong in rural Hadley, MA. Henry Alford wrote the words to this harvest hymn in 1844 in rural England when the life of the village during the winter depended upon the bounty of the harvest.

During the time of harvest it is a natural time to Give God all the glory and thanks for all that has been given to us. I continue to be so appreciative and thankful for all the amazing people who give of their time and talent for the music ministry here at Oakland. To those of you who ring bells, sing in the choir, bake goods for receptions after performances and to those of you who continue to support and encourage the music, I say, THANK YOU!!
