Friends, this is exciting! Yet, it comes with a responsibility that will have God's accountability. As Summer approaches, please, do not let the "Summer lull" steal the joys of our spiritual and physical growth. Enjoy your vacations, travel to see family, relax, and refresh. You need this. However, please be sure to stay engaged and connected with your Church and all that is happening here in person and online.


